The top three (3) candidates, although well qualified in terms of their experience and knowledge, were not suitable for this consultancy because as a part of the capacity building objective, this consultant is expected to transition into the mainstream of public service under the Ministry of Energy, as a full time employee beyond ERCAP. The three (3) highest ranked candidates surpassed the retirement age of 55 years as stipulated under the Public Service regulation. This automatically impede them from entering the public service beyond ERCAP.
