

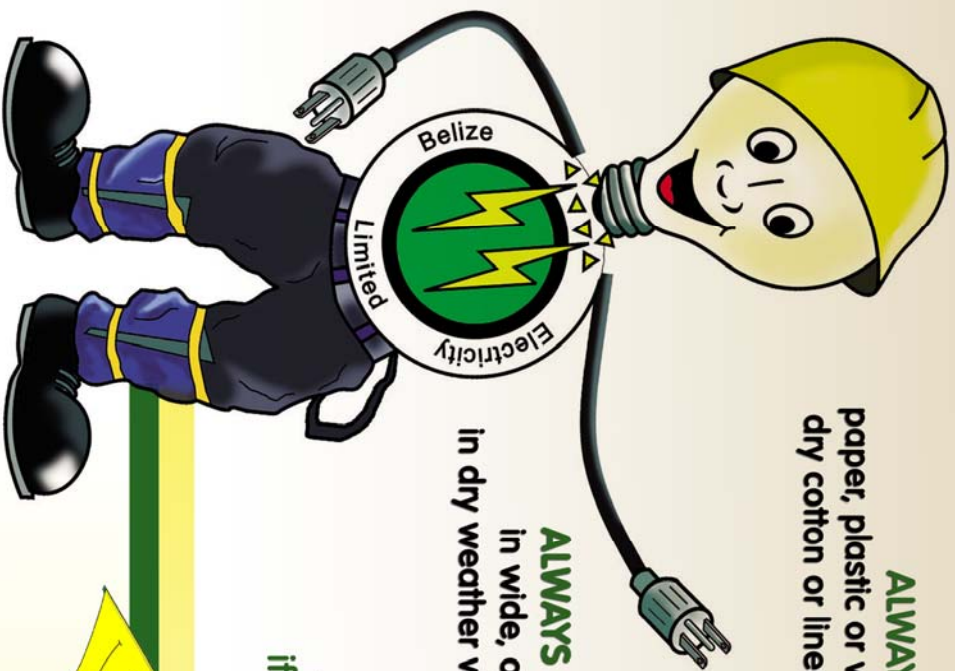
# Kite Flying...

**Keep your distance  
from power lines!**

**ALWAYS Use:**  
paper, plastic or wood to build kites  
dry cotton or linen string to fly kites

**ALWAYS Fly Kites:**  
in wide, open areas  
in dry weather with clear visibility

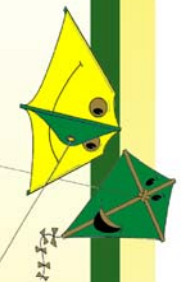
**ALWAYS call BEL at 0-800-235-2273  
if your kite gets caught in a power line**



**NEVER Fly Kites:**  
near power lines  
(You could be electrocuted)  
in wet or stormy weather  
near T.V. and radio aerials  
in the path of aircrafts  
or near highways

**NEVER attempt  
to remove your kite  
from a power line  
(You could be electrocuted)**

**NEVER Use:**  
wire, metallic thread  
or wire-reinforced strings  
to build or fly kites
