BEL Restores Power to Southern Belize after Fault on Transmission Line Causes Power Outage

At 8:16 p.m. yesterday, power supply to Southern Belize was interrupted after a fault occurred on the 34kV transmission line running from La Democracia Village to Dangriga Town.

Belize Electricity Limited (BEL) immediately dispatched work crews to the field and at 11:10 p.m. power supply was restored to most areas of Independence Village. By 12:25 a.m., today, both Dangriga and Punta Gorda Towns were energized and by 12:30 a.m. power was restored to the remaining service areas in Southern Belize.

BEL continues to investigate the cause of the power outage. The Company regrets any inconvenience caused by this outage and will provide customers with more information as it becomes available.
