Article 1 Subject

1.1 The subject of the contract shall be:

1	Step-Up Transformer	A step-up transformer is an electrical device designed to increase the voltage of an alternating current (AC) while reducing the current proportionally to maintain power balance. It operates on the principle of electromagnetic induction and is a critical component in power distribution systems.

The **place of acceptance** of the supplies shall be **BEL's Storage Facility, Ladyville, Belize**. The time limits for delivery shall be 185 days after contract signature by both parties. The Incoterm applicable shall be DAP⁴ at the customs entry points of Belize. The implementation period of tasks shall run from month/day/year to month/day/year.

Transportation from entry point to BEL's Storage Facility, in Ladyville, Belize will be conducted by a BEL broker.

1.2 The contractor shall comply strictly with the terms of the special conditions and the technical annex.

Article 2 Origin

The rules of origin of the goods are defined in Article 10 of the special conditions.

Article 3 Price

3.1 The price of the supplies shall be that shown on the financial offer (specimen in Annex IV). The total maximum contract price shall be US Dollars (USD).

3.2 Payments shall be made in accordance with the general and/or special conditions (Articles 26 to 28).

Article 4 Order of precedence of contract documents

The contract is made up of the following documents, in order of precedence:

- the contract agreement;
- the special conditions
- the general conditions (Annex I);
