- Complete annual audits on vegetation works conducted by Distribution Operations teams in service areas countrywide.
- Administer and manage vegetation management records with the use of GIS Technology.
- Lead service areas in maintaining the danger tree removal program and their IVM program in areas of tree cut permissions.
- Develop, and implement an annual species eradication program as a solution for rapid growth areas across the country.
- Develop and carry out an annual training program on updated company-approved vegetation control practices for all Distribution Operations technical staff. The training program includes but is not limited to pruning techniques, felling techniques, and basic Arborist training.
- Develop a vegetation certification program with annual refresher training for contractors, with the aim of qualifying their teams in techniques of pruning, rope and spur climbing, felling and line clearing. The program will also include electrical hazards training, job planning, basic Arborist training, and chemical application.
- Manage the execution of contracts for all vegetation works assigned to the unit, including but not limited to contracts with vegetation contractors and for rental of heavy duty equipment.
