BEL Explains Extended Outage

On Friday, February 8, Belize Electricity Limited (BEL) relocated power lines that supply Ladyville and a portion of Belize City, as requested by the Ministry of Works to continue construction of the airport link road.

These works resulted in scheduled outages up until 4:00 p.m. for customers from Mile 1 to 37 along the Philip Goldson Highway and from Mile 1 to 25 along the George Price Highway.

Upon completion of BEL's works, an excavator involved in the road construction accidentally broke one of the newly installed poles. The extent of the works, compounded by this accident, caused some customers to remain without power until 8:00 p.m.

BEL sincerely apologizes to customers for the extended outage and inconvenience.
