- Maintain a safe following distance from other vehicles.
- Relocate to higher ground early, when it is safe to do so. Water levels and the rate the water is flowing can change quickly during a flood. Monitor local radio, television or social media for weather updates.
- Avoid driving or walking in flooded areas, which can have hidden dangers such fallen power lines, debris and potholes.
- Assume all wires are electrically charged, including cable TV feeds.
