BEL Restoration Update Saturday, November 5, 2022

Belize Electricity Limited continues to restore power to the most affected areas in Belize and Cayo Districts that suffered damages to the power system as a result of Hurricane Lisa. Since the “All Clear” was issued, our teams have been working around the clock to restore power as safely and as efficiently as possible.

As of 7:00 a.m. on Saturday, November 5, 2022, we were able to restore power to 98% of customers in Cayo District, 95% in Belize City, and 78% in rural Belize District.

Areas being restored today in Belize City include portion of Belama Phase 2, Belama Phase 3, Belama Phase 4, portion of King’s Park, areas surrounding the Belize Municipal Air Strip, and other localized areas including small sections of downtown Belize City.

Areas being restored today in rural Belize District include Lord’s Bank, Vista del Mar, Western Paradise, Hattieville, Mile 25 on the George Price Highway, and portions of the Belize River Valley.



In the hardest-hit areas, there may be customers who are unable to receive power to their homes due to extensive damage to the power system. These include customers in the Belize River Valley areas beyond Burrell Boom who will continue to experience outage into Sunday, November 6, 2022.

Our line teams have been systematically completing repairs to the main feeders and today our teams will be dealing with low voltage issues for localized areas and individual customers.

We appreciate everyone’s patience and understanding as our teams continue working diligently to restore services within the communities. While you may not see our teams working in your area know that BEL’s power grid is heavily interconnected, and our teams are working throughout the system to restore power as safely and efficiently as possible.
