BEL Prepares for Power System Upgrades and Maintenance Works in Belize City

Our Transmission, Distribution and Substation teams are gearing up for power system upgrades in Belize City to improve the reliability of the power supply and meet the growing energy demands of Customers in Belize City.

The scheduled works will require an 8-hour power interruption from **7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on Sunday, May 7, 2023**, that will affect Customers in the entire Belize City area and along the highways outside of Belize City. During this time, our teams will conduct the following works in the area:

- Interconnection of a temporary substation near the Lake Independence Boulevard
- Maintenance and system upgrades to the Westlake Substation at Mile 8 George Price Highway
- Maintenance and system upgrades to the transmission and distribution system around Belize City
- Maintenance and upgrades to the Belize City substation at Magazine Road

The temporary substation is being setup to serve as a backup to the Belize City substation which will be taken out of service later this year to undergo a major upgrade over an extended period of time.

These upgrades and system improvements are a part of our action plan to make our electricity service to our Customers even more reliable and more sustainable and to support the rapidly increasing demand for electricity throughout the country.
