



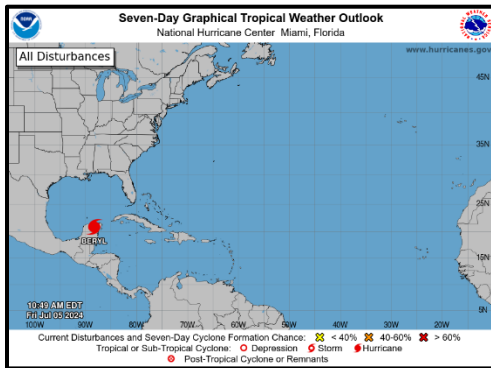

BEL Remains Vigilant During the Hurricane Season

Belize Electricity Limited (BEL) informs its Customers and the public that there were no power system losses during the passage of Hurricane Beryl, which made landfall before midnight last night over the Yucatán Peninsula, north of Belize. Our thoughts and prayers are with the communities in the Caribbean and Mexico which bore the brunt of the storm.



The National Emergency Management Organization announced the All-Clear at 7:51 a.m. today. While we were fortunate to avoid any damage to property or the national power system, BEL remains focused on our Hurricane Preparedness Plan and continues to be vigilant during this hurricane season.

We remind our Customers and the public that vegetation management—clearing or trimming trees that are close to power lines—is a key part of hurricane preparedness. The falling of trees on power lines is one of the primary causes of power interruptions during a storm.
