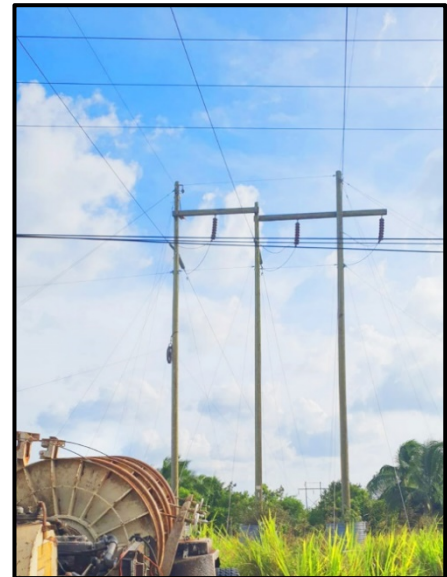

BEL Works to Improve Reliability of the Transmission Line Between Buena Vista and Belcogen

Belize Electricity Limited (BEL) informs Customers of planned maintenance works on the 115KV transmission line between Buena Vista Substation in Corozal and Belcogen Substation in Orange Walk. These works are necessary to replace damaged shield wires which serve to protect the transmission line against lightning strike.

Works started on Wednesday, March 13, and are scheduled to be completed by Wednesday, March 20, 2024. Customers in the Orange Walk District will experience two 5-minute daily power interruptions between 6:00 a.m. and 6:05 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. and 6:05 p.m. throughout the length of the planned works.



Transmission Line between Belcogen and Buena Vista

During the works, the national grid, except for Corozal and Orange Walk, will be supplied solely from local generation sources. Corozal and Orange Walk will be supplied with power sourced from Comision Federal de Electricidad (CFE) in Mexico. Customers will be informed immediately if any further vulnerability develops.

BEL apologizes for any inconveniences caused during this time. These maintenance works are essential to help prevent unplanned interruptions and to improve the reliability of power supply to Customers.
