Belize Electricity Limited Informs Customers of Urgent Maintenance Works

Belize Electricity Limited (BEL) informs our Customers of urgent maintenance works, scheduled to take place today, Saturday March 23, 2024, at the Mollejon and Vaca Generation and Substation facilities in the Cayo district.

The works are necessary to ensure the reliability and efficiency of our power infrastructure as we prepare for the upcoming high demand season.

With these facilities offline, our overall generation capacity will be tightly constrained. This means that the failure of any major generation unit will likely result in power interruptions, particularly during the afternoon peak hours.

In the meantime, BEL is making all efforts to maintain stable and reliable power supply to our Customers and will immediately inform Customers if there are any further developments.

Looking ahead, temperatures are projected to exceed 100 degrees Fahrenheit in the next few days in most areas of the country, increasing the strain on our power resources.

We urge our Customers to look out for our advisory bulletins during this time and to assist us by implementing energy conservation measures where possible, particularly during the early afternoon.

We thank our Customers and the public who rely on our services for their understanding and cooperation as we continue to make every effort to deliver safe, reliable, and sustainable electricity services and energy solutions to you.
