## BEL Team Departs for Jamaica to Assist with Hurricane Restoration

Belize Electricity Limited (BEL) has deployed a team to assist Jamaica Public Service Company Limited (JPS), the sole distributor of electricity in Jamaica, in their power restoration efforts following the passage of Hurricane Melissa. The team departs today, Wednesday, November 12, 2025.

Hurricane Melissa, a Category 5 Hurricane with wind speeds of over 180 mph, made landfall in Jamaica around midday on Tuesday, October 28, 2025, causing significant damage to homes, businesses, and critical infrastructure, including Jamaica's power transmission and distribution systems. The central and western parishes, in particular, were severely impacted by the storm.
